#### FOREST PARK MEDICAL CENTER FOUNTAIN

Kusser Fountainworks worked with the Dallas-based architecture firm BOKA Powell to design this three-level granite fountain for the entrance to the surgery facility at the Forest Park Medical Center in Frisco, Texas. The lower pool has 24 clear stream nozzles, with 16 water-level-dependent cascade nozzles surrounding a frothy nozzle. ●

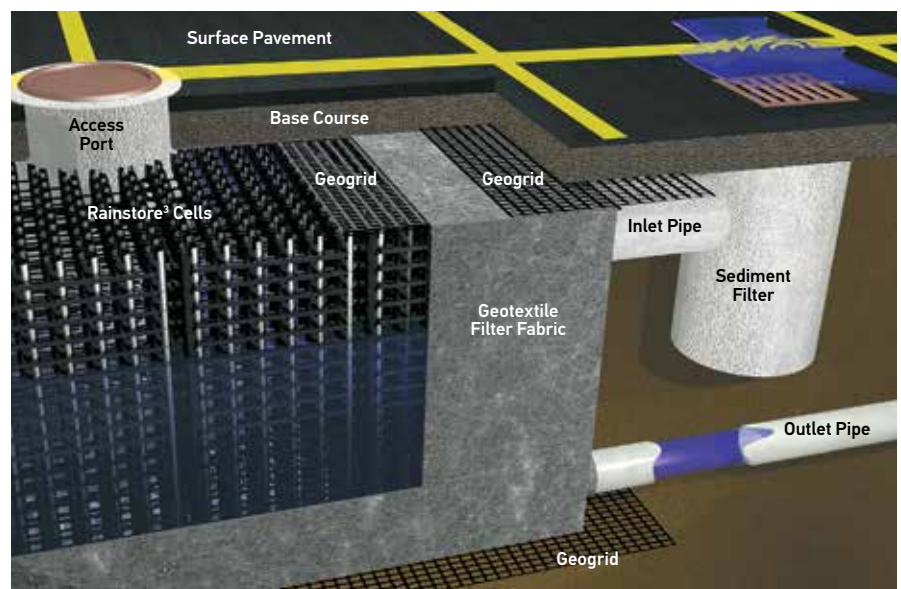

#### RAINSTORE<sup>3</sup>



Designers who don't have space for detention ponds but want to capture and store stormwater may want to consider an underground option. Rainstore<sup>3</sup> by Invisible Structures stores stormwater in a modular, stackable structure (stacked 24 high in the photo above) made from injection-molded plastic. Each panel contains 36 vertical columns and can tolerate heavy loads, so Rainstore<sup>3</sup> can support driveways, parking lots, or other small structures above it. ●
